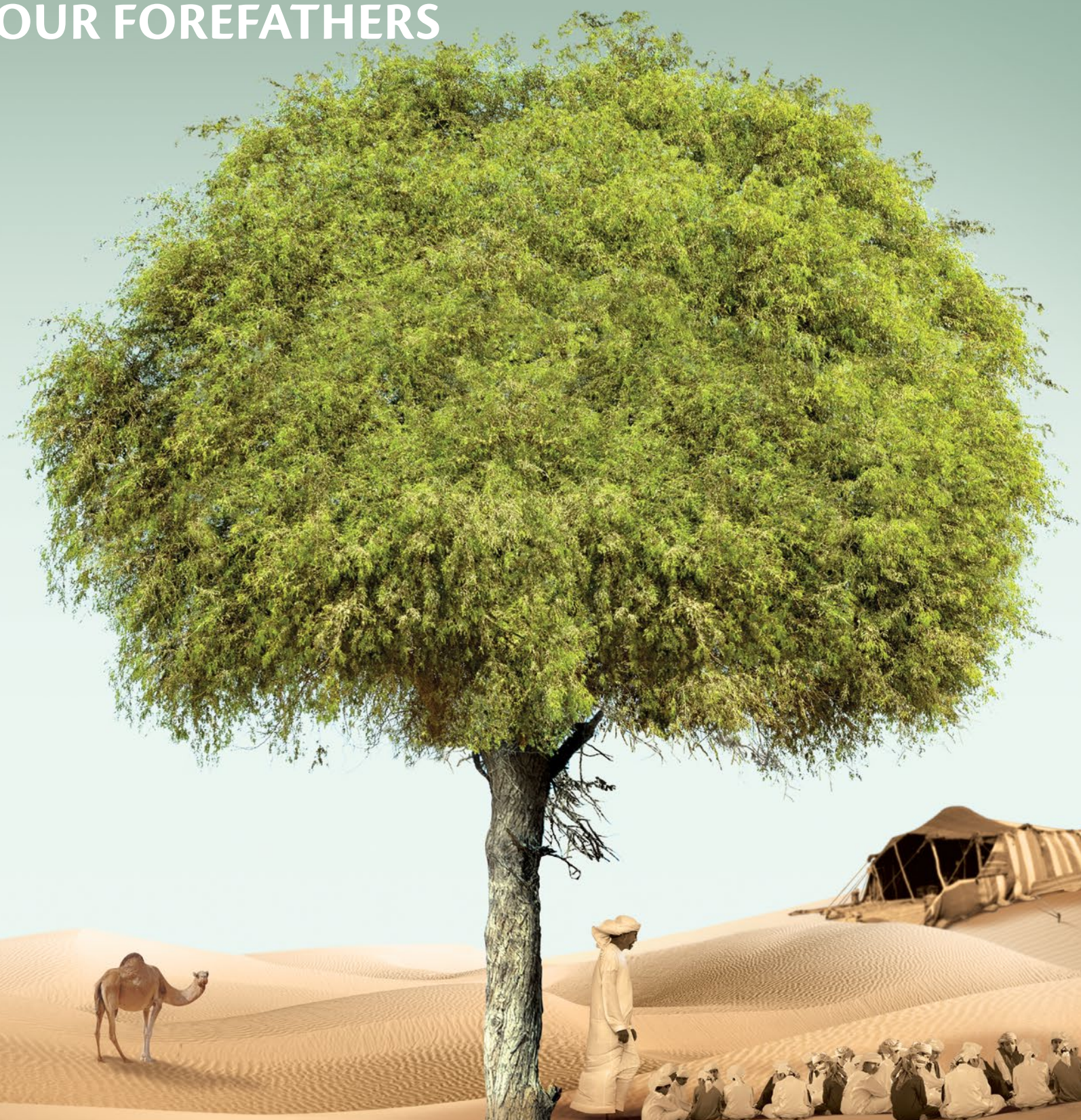




USES OF THE GHAF TREE WHY OUR NATIONAL TREE WAS SO IMPORTANT TO OUR FOREFATHERS
